“Here I live, here I vote. “

On September 24th, 2017, the general election will take place in Germany. Almost 450,000 citizens who have the right to vote, live in the Nuremberg metropolitan area and have been registered there for more than 3 months. However, more than 100,000 citizens resident in the city of Nuremberg are not allowed to vote because they are not German citizens. In addition to the official election in Nuremberg, a symbolic election will take place on the 24th of September, 2017 in order to give those citizens with a foreign status the opportunity to participate in a symbolic election.

The aim of the symbolic election is to point out that the German election system is flawed regarding the right to vote for foreign nationals living in Germany and at the same time to promote the right for those citizens to be allowed to vote in local elections.

People who live in Nuremberg are directly affected by, for example, tram fares, the availability of kindergarten places, or by decisions concerning urban housing matters, whether they were born in Nuremberg, Hamburg, Madrid, Ankara or Duala. Regardless of their place of birth or nationality, those who have reached the voting age should be allowed to vote in municipal elections. The integration council, the city council, as well as the mayor of Nuremberg all support this view. However, the final decision with regards to foreign nationals having the right to vote in local elections can only be made with the approval of a two-thirds majority in the German Parliament.

The right to vote is a core principle of any democratic society. Giving foreign citizens the right to vote would enhance the integration process and signifies political equality for all residents. In 15 of the 28 EU nations, foreign nationals already have the right to vote in municipal elections.

We ask that you go to your local polling station 2 weeks before the general election takes place (between the 11th- 22nd of September 2017). Here you can symbolically vote for your party in the German Parliament in Berlin. (The list of polling stations will be available before the beginning of September).

The symbolic elections will be organized under the alliance and the leadership of AGABY and the Integration Council of the City of Nuremberg. They call upon all citizens to participate.

It will take place in various cities in Germany in 2017.
